Three of the articles relate to events of national importance, so published histories were often referred to; however, Mike Hinson spent long hours seeking out newspaper reports on the Boer War, borough records, parish registers and hearth tax returns gave information about local participants in the Civil War, and Roy Billingham deciphered messages engraved on window panes at New Hall. Janet Jordan's discovery of Sarah Holbeche's *Diary* made her curious about the Gambles, while maps and surveys helped Alan Howells to interpret the building at Birmingham Road. The research collections held in the local history section of Sutton Coldfield Library are an invaluable resource for the town.
