

This Directory offers relatively few clues for the area around Coleshill Street, Mill Street and Church Hill, as only names are provided. Addresses are limited to areas such as Maney, Langley, Little Sutton etc.

<u>1835</u>

Pigot's Directory mentions Charles Brentnall as being the Overseer of the Workhouse in Mill Street.

Alice Alldridge is noted as being connected with the 'Old Sun' Inn in Coleshill Street. There is no mention of the 'Royal Oak'.
